Price Tier	Cost	Description
<b>Tier 1</b> Full Price	<b>\$1400</b>	Most accurately reflects the true cost of camp operations for each camper, including but not limited to: staff, meals, wear and tear of facilities and grounds, utilities, insurance, equipment repairs, overhead, and depreciation. Please pay this amount if you are able.
<b>Tier 2</b> 10% Subsidized*	<b>\$1260</b>	Reflects the basic cost of attending camp, including food, staff, program supplies, and limited maintenance expenses. This is a partially subsidized rate.
<b>Tier 3</b> 20% Subsidized*	<b>\$1120</b>	Reflects the most basic cost of attending camp, including food, staff, and supplies. This is a subsidized rate.
<b>Tier 4</b> Financial Assistance*	<b>VARIES</b>	Financial Assistance – Please select this option to apply for financial assistance. The YMCA financial assistance program uses a sliding scale to cover up to 80% of the total cost of camp. Please complete the financial assistance form in the registration process to be eligible. Financial Aid does not become available until January 1 <sup>st</sup> each year.

\*At YMCA Camp Sequoia Lake we believe that camp is for everyone, and money should never be the reason a kid can't come to camp. Because of this philosophy, all our youth programs have a Tiered Pricing system which allows families to honestly select the cost for camp they can afford, including our subsidized rates, without complicated paperwork or fear of judgement. Generous donors every year allow us to offer this option openly, and only financial aid scholarships covering more than 20% of the cost of camp require additional paperwork and personal finance information. All pricing tiers include full access to all camp activities and benefits with no change in the experience a child receives from one tier to another.
